


Blue Rock Quarry

History From 1917


- Original quarry on property created in 1917
- Land contracted and re-explored in 2003
- By 2007, peer-reviewed independent and expert evaluations (archaeology, habitat, health/safety/welfare, water, traffic) were completed & positive
- DNR recognized and announced this as a major new natural resource in 2008 & issued a protective registration status to insure the rock would not be abused by negative zoning



The Current Proposal - 2015

- We want to accent community benefits including over 100+ new jobs
- We want to adopt major community recommendations
- We want to illustrate how isolated the property is with a significant buffer and slow growth pattern







What Has Changed Since 2008? 12 Points

- 1. Quarry land owners control project
- 2. Quarry has not been a negative to property value sales
- 3. Insurance provided for wells, foundations, home values
- 4. New routing reduces 70% of quarry trucks through Dresser
- 5. Tourist train receives additional operating protection
- 6. Multiple choice of quarry operators



What Has Changed? continued

- 7. Ability to expand Harvey Stower 7 Lakes Trail through property and potentially link with Gandy Dancer Trail
- Idea for Blue Rock Nature Center and Glade Trails on 25 acres of pristine, undisturbed quarry property
- 9. Opportunity to offer tourist train, nature center and tours as packaged program
- 10. Quarry & Glades learning center and field trip lab studies for area schools



What Has Changed? continued

11. Community Benefits

- 180+ acres of new high tax property
- \$1 million in area revenue growth (State of WI)

12. New Area Jobs - Supporting 120 Families


- 20 sustainable family quarry jobs
- Hiring for 50 trucking jobs
- Additional 50 area growth jobs from quarry operation (State of WI estimate)
